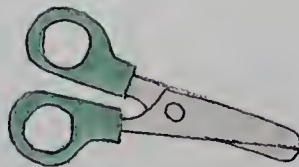


Use the letter **W** to make the tusks of a **walrus**.

Here is what you need:



white construction paper
letter W



scissors



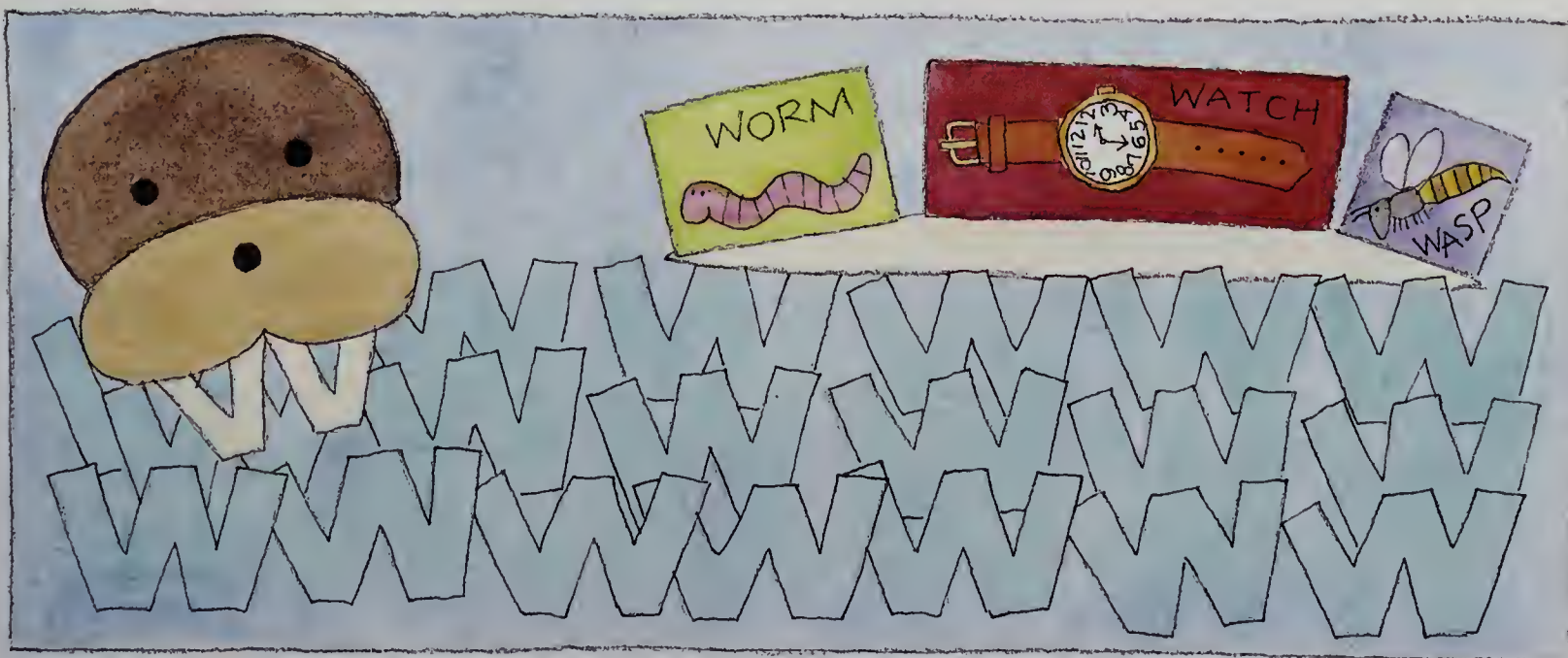
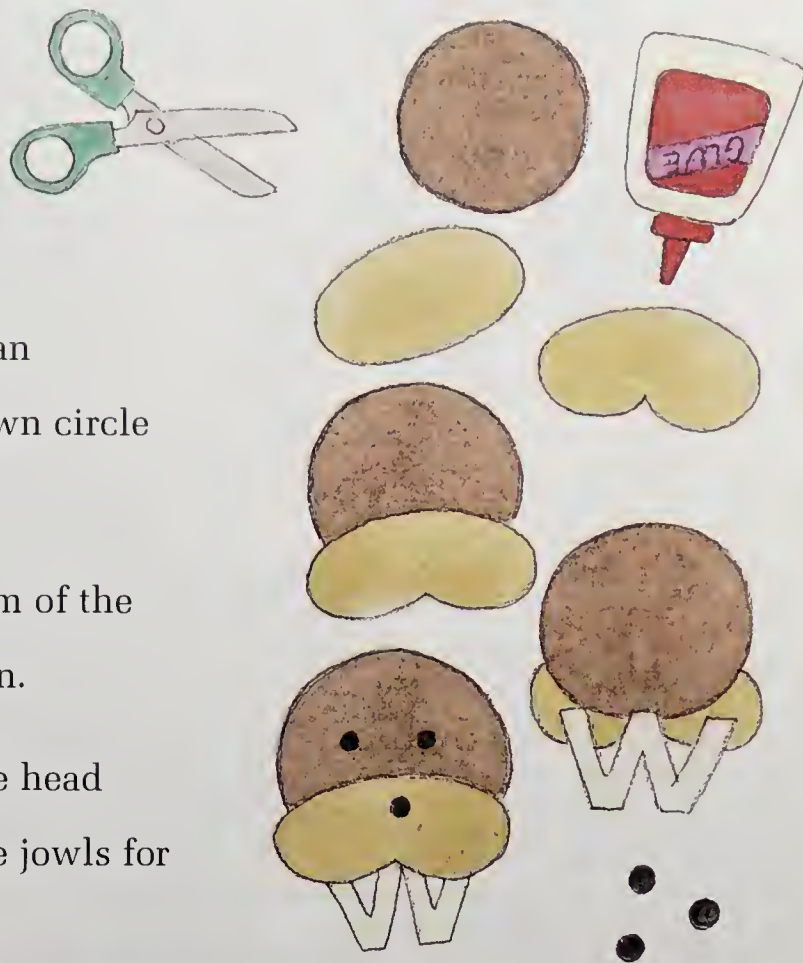

brown, tan, and black
construction paper

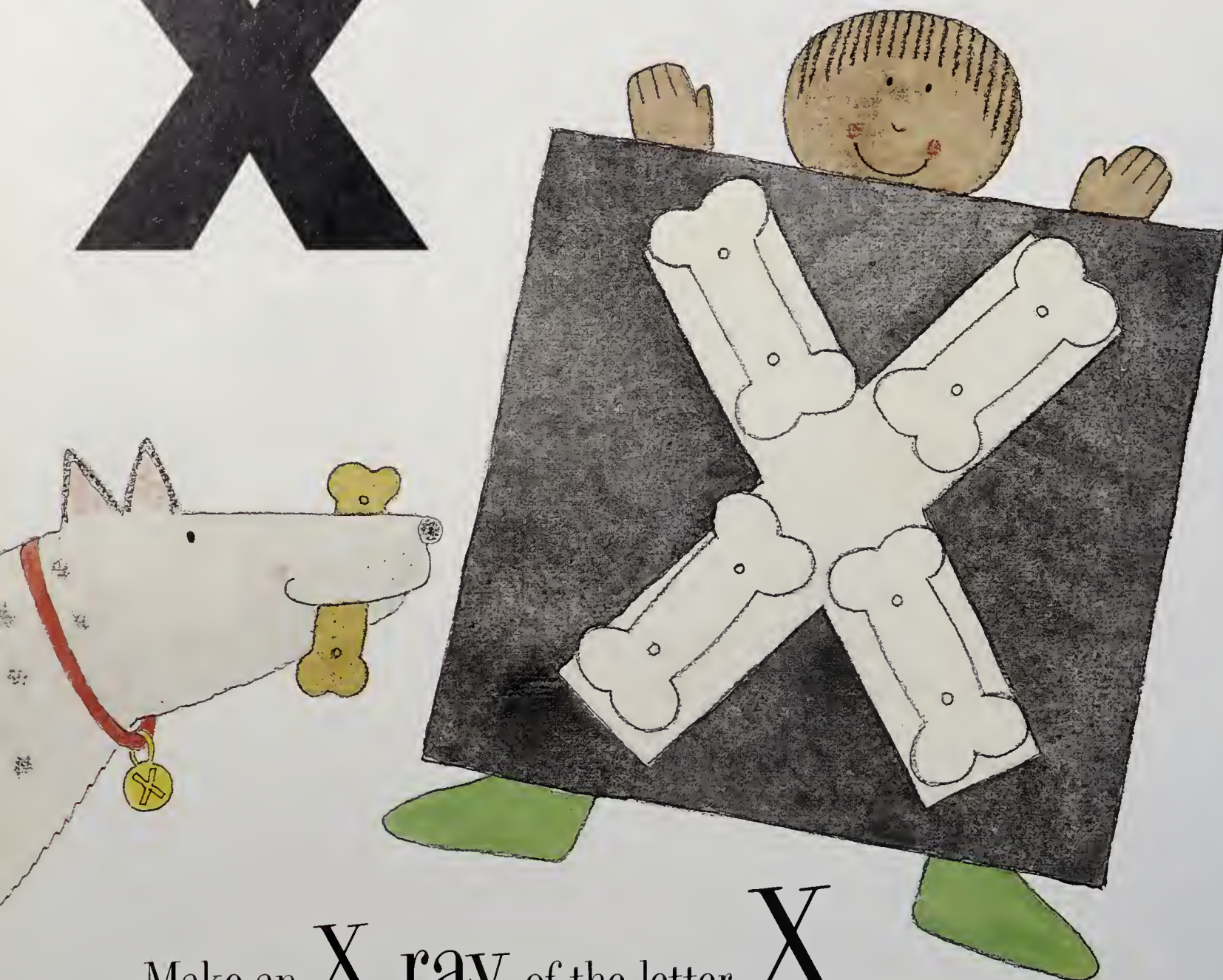
Here is what you do:

1. Cut a circle from the brown paper for the head of the walrus.
2. Cut an oval shape about as wide as the circle from the tan paper. Cut two bumps on one side of the oval like the top of a heart. Glue the tan paper, bump side down, to the bottom of the brown circle head to make the jowls for the walrus.
3. Glue the top of the letter W behind the bottom of the jowls so that it looks like two tusks hanging down.
4. Cut three small black circles. Glue two on the head for the eyes, and glue one on the top center of the jowls for the nose.



Cut lots of blue construction paper letter **W**s. Glue them to a sheet of blue paper to look like **waves** of **water**. Glue the head of the letter **W** **walrus** on the paper to look like it is sticking up out of the **water**. Cut an ice floe from **white** construction paper. Glue the ice floe in the **water**. Find some magazine pictures of things that begin with the letter **W** to glue on the ice floe.

Here is what you do:

1. Paint the four dog biscuits white and let them dry on the Styrofoam tray.
2. Cut a square of black paper slightly bigger than the paper X to be the X-ray machine.
3. Glue the X to the black paper square.
4. Cut a head and hands from the skin tone paper. Use the markers to give the head a face and hair.
5. Glue the bottom edge of the head behind the top of the black square of paper. Glue a hand sticking up on each side of the letter X.
6. Cut shoes from construction paper. Glue a shoe sticking out below the black paper from each side of the bottom of the letter X.
7. Glue a white "bone" on each part of the letter X.

Here is what you need:



two construction paper
letter Ys



trim, buttons, other
collage materials



white glue



markers



scissors



construction paper in

Here is what you do:

1. Glue the stems of the two letter Ys together with the forked part of each letter going in the opposite direction. This will be the body of the figure.

2. Cut a head, hands, and feet from the construction paper.

3. Glue hands on the ends of the top of one letter Y and the feet at the ends of the top of the other letter Y.

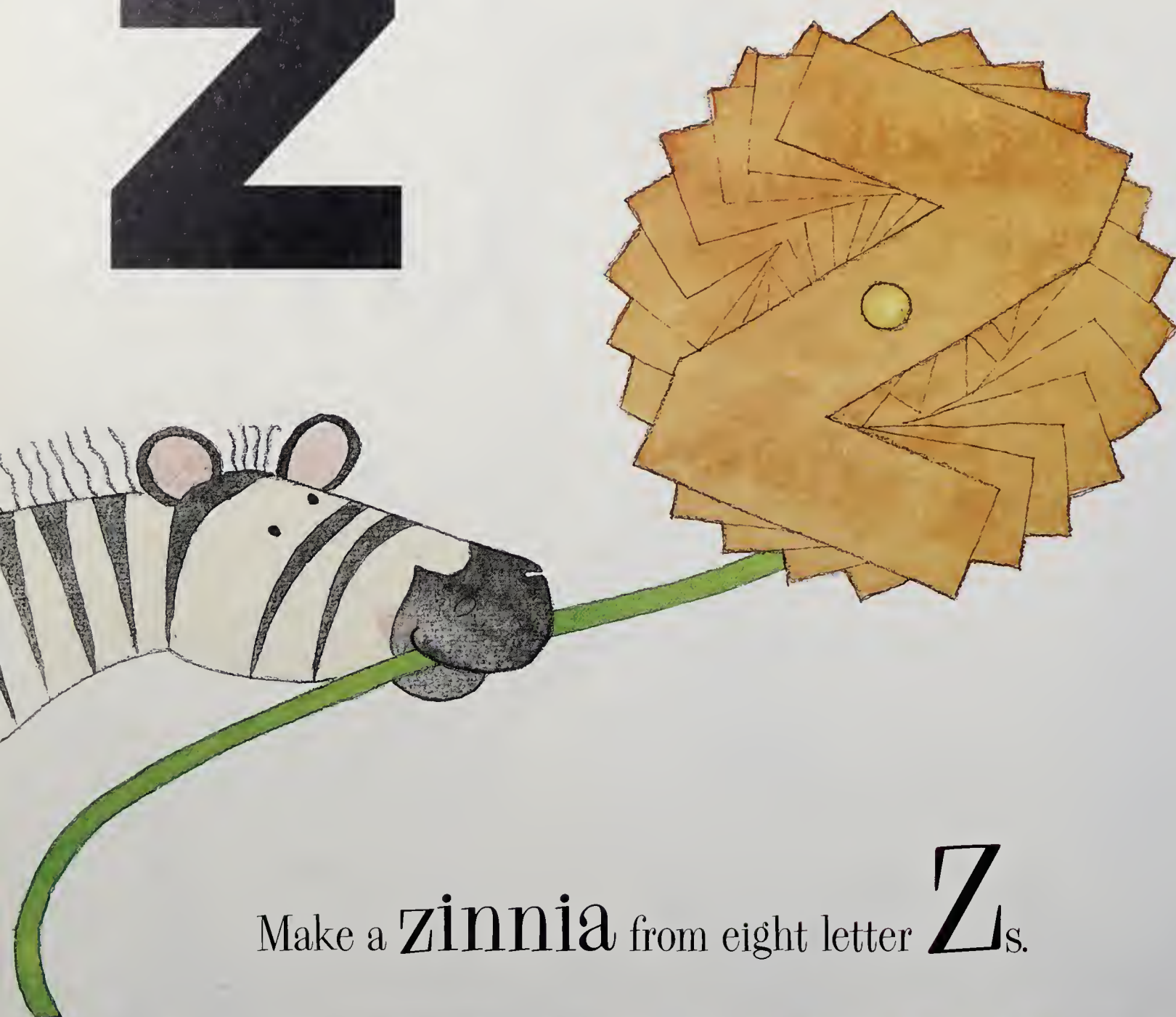
4. Draw a face on the head with the markers. Glue on some yarn bits for hair. Glue the head to the Y that has the hands glued to it.

5. Decorate the clothes using the collage materials.



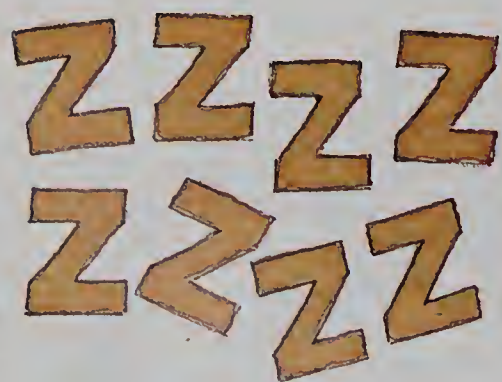

Make a **zinnia** from eight letter **Z**s.

Here is what you need:



eight construction paper
letter Zs in the same
bright color



scissors



pencil



paper
fastener



thin green ribbon



masking tape



small hole punch



white glue



piece of sticky-back
magnet

Here is what you do:

1. Stack the eight letter Zs.

Punch a small hole through the

middle of all eight letter Zs. You may need

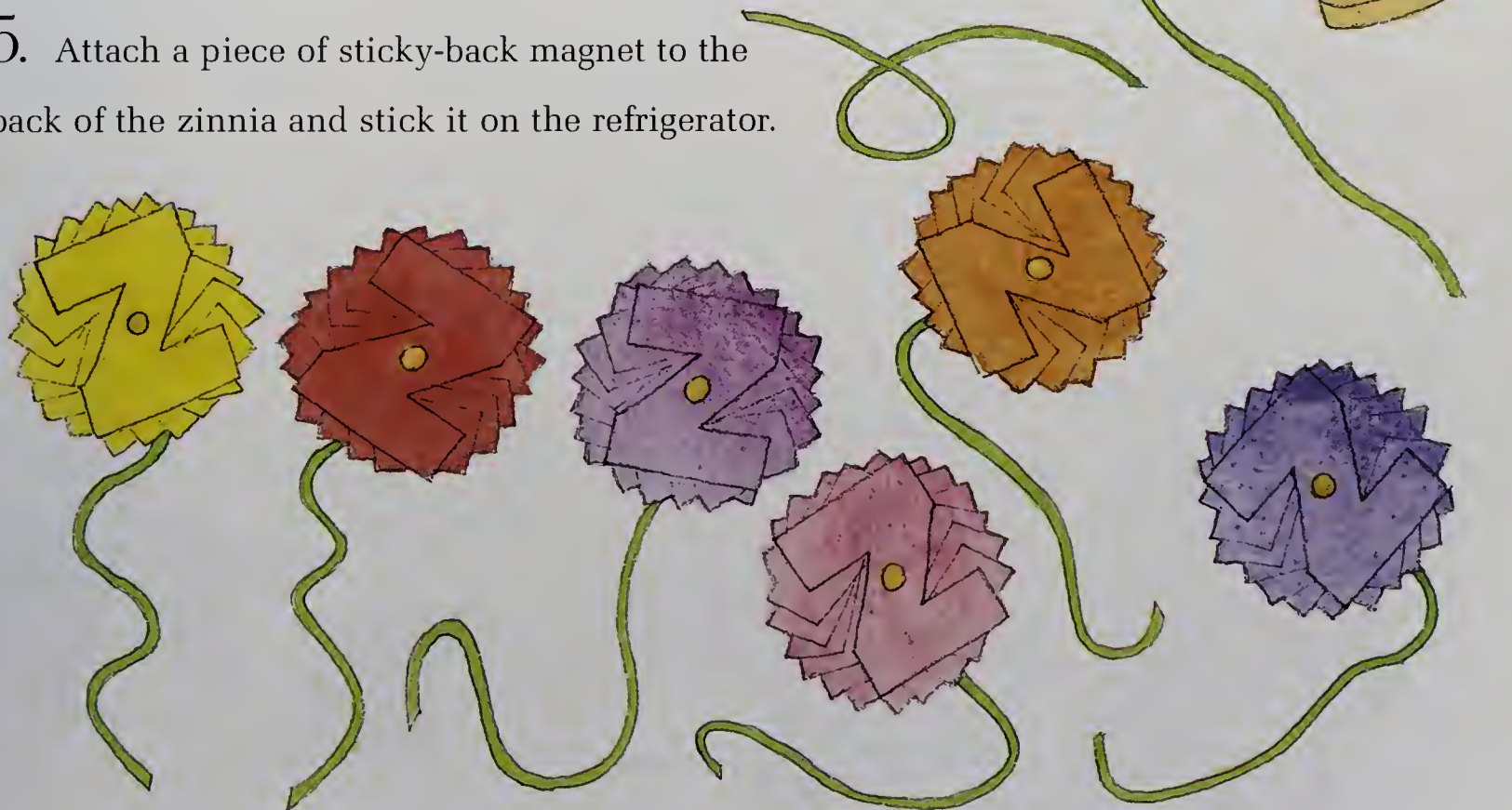
to do this in two piles of four Zs. Use a pencil to mark where to punch the hole in the second stack so that the Zs line up.

2. Holding the letter Zs in a stack, attach them together by putting the paper fastener through the holes and bending out the ends in the back.

3. Fan out the Zs around the fastener until they form a complete circle, the Z zinnia.

4. Cut a 12-inch (30-cm) length of green ribbon. Glue one end of the ribbon to the back of the flower so that it hangs down to form a stem. Cover the glued end with a piece of masking tape to secure it while the glue dries.

5. Attach a piece of sticky-back magnet to the back of the zinnia and stick it on the refrigerator.
